

List of necessary documents to presented during inspection of Apiaries

- 1. Ownership document for the apiary. Registration document for the apiary,** copy of the apiary registration should be presented to the control body if necessary (or copy of registration card of the agricultural producer).
- 2. Sketches of the apiary location and buildings used for honey centrifugation, storage rooms including storage facilities, etc., if applicable.** Copies should be presented to the control body.
- 3. Map of the area–** Copy. The situation of the apiaries should be indicated on the map – area of collection (bee flight), water supply which the bees use, the way to reach the apiary as well as all possible sources of contamination, if applicable.
- 4. Register of the activities concerning the apiary. Diary of the apiary.** All activities concerning the apiary should be described in the diary, such as inspection, feeding, treatments, etc. If necessary, copies should be presented to the control body.
- 5. Declaration for origin of the bee families –** if available. Copies should be presented to the control body.
- 6. Invoices and delivery receipts, purchase and sales documentation.** Purchase documentation for materials and other expenses concerning apicultural activities.
